

Dudley Children and Young People's Plan 2008 – 2011

Dudley governors are encouraged to obtain a copy of the above plan, produced by the Dudley Children's Trust and available from the Authority website at www.dudley.gov.uk/education-and-learning . Whilst recognising that not all governors do have web access it should be possible for schools to provide copies for GB members.

The details provided within the Plan covers the 25% or so of our population defined as "children and young people" (aged 0 to 19 years), and represent an extremely clear and revealing source of information about such diverse elements as areas of deprivation, population trends, vulnerable children and young people and how the Trust is setting about prioritising its work.

The Plan matches up to the five outcomes from Every Child Matters, determines what is going well and where more work is needed and, crucially, provides direct input from children, the results of the TellUs2 Survey of 2007. Governing Bodies may wish to discuss this Plan in the context of their own School Improvement Plan.
